Dear Parent/Guardian

RE: Sixth Form Induction Thursday 27th June and Friday 28th June

I hope your daughter's time at the Folkestone School for Girls has been memorable, and that they wish to continue their memories by joining the sixth form here in September.

In order to help students become familiar with the subjects they have chosen, as well as A Level study in general, we have organised 2 days of induction for year 11 students coming to FSG for their Sixth Form Studies from September. The induction days will be held on Thursday 27th June and Friday 28th June starting at 8.50am and will run as follows:

Thursday 27th June

8.50am: Arrival and Registration outside the Main School Hall

9.00am: Welcome assembly and breakfast in the Main School Hall and canteen area

10am till 3:30pm: Taster sessions for subjects students have expressed an interest in studying next year

Friday 28th June

9.00am start – taster sessions will run in periods 1, 2 and 3 followed by a 'roundup and summer farewell' afternoon.

Students are allowed to go off site at lunch time if they wish to. However, if they are planning to go off site they need to ensure they return ready for 1:25pm for afternoon session. If going off site during lunch time please be aware that students will need to sign out at reception so it is known that they are not on site for the lunch period for safety reasons.

During the induction period, students will have an opportunity to speak to teachers about their chosen subjects, learn a range of study skills to help them to prepare for next year, and reflect on their pathway moving forwards.

Results day

The GCSE examination results will be issued by the school on Thursday 22nd August and will be available for collection from the school between 9:30am and 11:30am.

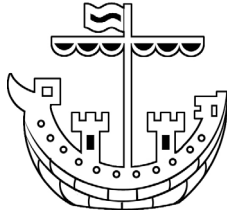
There will be members of staff present at these times to offer support and advice should any student need it.

If a student is unable to attend to collect their results they need to send an email to Mrs S Burden by 5th July, nominating a representative to do this for them, if doing so the nominated person will need to bring with them photograph ID on the day to verify that the results are being handed to the correct person. Alternatively if a student wishes for their results to be sent via post (these will be posted on results day and will therefore be received later), please provide Mrs Burden with a stamped addressed envelope by 5th July.

Members of staff will be available on Thursday 22nd August to discuss any option changes, and Miss Robinson will also be available from 1pm until 3pm the day after results day (Friday 23th August) if students have any further queries regarding sixth form options.
