- Modern Foreign Language (French or Spanish)

Possible combinations:

- Geography + Language
- History + Language
- French + Spanish
- Geography + History


## Modern Foreign Languages

## GCSE Science- 2 routes

## COMBINED SCIENCE (TRILOGY)

- Students study all 3 sciences
- Leads to 2 GCSE qualifications
- Accepted progression route into A Level science subjects


## SEPARATE SCIENCE

- Students study all 3 sciences
- Leads to 3 GCSE qualifications
- Study each subject at a greater depth
