## Modern Foreign Languages


"If you talk to a man in a language he understands, that goes to his head. If you talk to him in his own language, that goes to his heart."

## GCSE Science— 2 routes

#### **COMBINED SCIENCE (TRILOGY)**

- Students study all 3 sciences
- Leads to 2 GCSE qualifications
- Accepted progression route into A Level science subjects

#### **SEPARATE SCIENCE**

- Students study all 3 sciences
- Leads to 3 GCSE qualifications
- Study each subject at a greater depth

For now, for all Year 9 students, everyone just does science!
