Year 13 Mock Examinations - Wednesday 5 November to Friday 21 November 2025

I am pleased to be able to share with you the final details of the mock exams that your child will complete during the November mock exam period.

Preparation

As well as revision it is important that students:

- · Have enough sleep the night before their exams
- Arrive for the examination on time
 - 8.20 for a morning examination
 - 12.40 for an afternoon examination
- Are hydrated and have a good breakfast before coming to school. This will help with their concentration.

We are scheduling the exams to start part way through the week to allow the students time to rest over the October break.

Early lunch arrangements will be in place for afternoon examinations.

Uniform, full school uniform is expected, please be mindful of the clear wrist policy and ensure that your child has their ID badge along with all necessary equipment for their exam.

Attendance, call the school reception at least 30 minutes before the start time to advise of any absence.

Homework, from 3 November will be focused on revision.

Revision, can take place in lesson time, no new content will be taught (other than Criminology and Sport).

These mock exams will enable students to practise their revision techniques, and to better understand how to work effectively in timed exam conditions. They will also provide your child's teachers with a clear indication of where they may need additional support to be able to achieve their full potential during the summer 2026 exam period.
